



# WSD FLY STRIKE POWDER

## Product Description

WSD FLY STRIKE POWDER is a treatment for blowfly strike of sheep and a wound treatment for livestock.

## Type of Preparation

WSD FLY STRIKE POWDER is a ready-to use powder for topical application to struck areas or as a wound dressing containing Diazinon 15g/kg, Piperonyl Butoxide 0.8g/kg, and Pyrethrins 1g/kg.

## Indications

**Sheep and other livestock:** To treat or prevent blowfly strike, including after dehorning, mulesing or other wounds

**Milking sheep:** Should not be used in sheep producing milk for human consumption.

## Dosage

Always refer to the label.

Shear wool or clip hair from the affected parts. Apply powder to the wound, introducing it into any cavities beneath the skin. Dust the wool and skin bordering the strike, particularly areas between skin wrinkles. After marking, mulesing and dehorning, apply liberally to the affected area.

## Advice on use

- It is important to coat the area thoroughly.
- Following fly strike, re-treatment of the affected area may be required.
- All preparations containing diazinon should be treated with CAUTION.

## Withholding periods

### Meat withholding:

**Sheep, goats and pigs:** 14 days

**Cattle:** 3 days

**Export slaughter interval:** 3 days (cattle) and 21 days (sheep)

### Milk withholding:

**Sheep:** Not for use in sheep producing milk for human consumption

**Cattle:** 6 hours

**Goats:** 48 hours

**Wool withholding:** NIL provided it is applied as directed and not directly onto woolled areas.

## Shelf Life

24 months from the date of manufacture

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**RESTRAINTS:** Not to be used for any purpose, or in any manner contrary to this label unless authorised under appropriate legislation.

**DO NOT USE** on female cattle, sheep or goats which are producing or may in the future produce milk or milk products for human consumption.

Wound dressing, after marking, mulesing and dehorning. Dust the wound using a suitable container, ensuring the powder enters any crevices and cavities under the skin.

For general wounds: clip hair or shear affected areas and dust them lightly.

For strike, mulesing, dehorning: apply the powder in ample quantities to the area affected.

**WITHHOLDING PERIOD:** Sheep and Goats (Meat): DO NOT USE less than fourteen (14) days before slaughter for human consumption.

Cattle (Meat): DO NOT USE less than three (3) days before slaughter for human consumption.

**DO NOT USE** on female cattle, sheep or goats which are producing or may in the future produce milk or milk products for human consumption.

**SAFETY DIRECTIONS:** Repeated minor exposure may have a cumulative poisoning effect. Repeated exposure may cause allergic disorders. Sensitive workers should use protective clothing. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale dust. When using the product wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and washable hat. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use, wash contaminated clothing.

**FIRST AID:** If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Phone 13 11 26).

**MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET:** Additional information is listed in the Material Safety Data Sheet, which can be obtained from the supplier.

**PROTECTION OF FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND THE ENVIRONMENT:** Dangerous to fish. Do not contaminate streams, rivers and waterways with the product or used containers.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

**STORAGE:** Store below 30°C (room temperature) in the closed, original container, in a dry, well-ventilated area, and protect from light.
